Reading Homework

From this week, children will bring home a SATs style book. Every week, they must complete the next test. This homework is expected to be completed independently and should take them approximately 20-30 minutes. This will be set on a Friday and expected to be back by the following Wednesday. If there are any changes to this, this will be communicated via Arbor.

Spelling/SPAG Homework

We will be looking at spelling on a daily basis. If any words come home with your children, please talk to them about their spelling words: what sounds make them up, what they mean. It would be useful if you could also talk to your child about the words and put them into sentences.

Similar to the Maths homework, children will bring home a SATs booklet with SPAG type questions in them. This is brought home by Friday and to be returned by Wednesday. Please support us by encouraging your child to complete their homework on time. This should take them no longer than 20 minutes.

Maths Homework

Similar to the Reading and SPAG homework, children will bring home a Maths SATs style homework book. There will be questions in there that are arithmetic style and reasoning style (this is similar to word problems). Maths homework is set, like the SPAG and Reading on a Friday and to be returned by the following Wednesday.

In addition to any activities sent home, children will be expected to spend time each week on Times Tables Rockstars every week.

Other important notices

PE day this half term in Year 2 is on a **Tuesday and Wednesday.** Please ensure your child have correct PE kits and ideally to remove any earrings before school.

Our school day

In Year 6, children will enter through the Villa Vic gate between **8:40am** and **8:50am**, and are to be collected at **3:20pm**. Please ensure children arrive and are picked up promptly. If they have siblings, they will collect them from their classrooms (if their siblings are younger) or wait to be collected (if the siblings are older)
