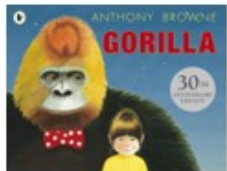




Autumn One Term Year 5

English



We are reading...

To focus on:

- Relative Clauses – using 'who' to try and add more detail in stories
- Repetition – the importance of repeating in stories to build description.
- Pronouns – the use of pronouns (he, she, it) in our writing.



In class, we will be reading the book *Kensuke's Kingdom* by Michael Morpurgo.

In Year 5, our guided reading is done as a whole class, where the teacher reads the story, showing the children a model of reading out loud with fluency and expression.

Maths

In Maths we will learn to:

- Read, Write and compare 5-digit numbers.
- Add and Subtract up to 4-digit numbers mentally and written.
- Multiply and divide numbers by 10 and 100
- Understand place value in decimal numbers

Science

We will be looking at:

- The life cycle of mammals
- The life cycles of Amphibians and Insects
- The life cycles of Birds
- Reproduction in Plants
- Reproduction in Animals.

RE

In RE we will be:

- Finding a deeper understanding of who I am.
- Thinking about the talents and qualities that make us a unique individual.
- What commitments we make to God – for example, in baptism and marriage.
- Undertaking a mission to help others in our school (Nursery) to help in their reading

Geography

In Geography we will be exploring:

- The climate and the Equator
- The different climate ones that exist around the world
- Hot Deserts (There can be cold deserts too!)
- Temperate climates like our own in the UK which doesn't have extremes of hot and cold.
- Cold Environments

PE

In PE we will be working with Newcastle United Foundation to help build our football skills. This will include

- Dribbling skills,
- Tactics for defending and attacking
- Shooting skills
- Passing skills
- Teamwork and games.

Music

In Music this half term, we will be working with Mr Miller, our fabulous Music teacher, who will be teaching us:

- Different types of songs with a focus on if they are in a major or minor key.
- To make choices about the music we hear and given reasons why we like or dislike a piece.
- How to read and compose our own simple pieces of music.

PSHCE

In PSHCE we will be looking at:

- The Zones of Regulation to help us understand our emotions better
- Valuing our differences and similarities
- Recognising others' feelings

Computing

In Computing we will be learning:

- How computers can be connected together to form systems
- To use a search engine to find information and how to improve searches
- How search engines select results and how they rank them in importance
- To understand why the order of search results is important and why this happens.

Art

In Art we will be:

- Drawing houses from observation, looking closely at details and interpreting them accurately.
- Investigating the work of Hundertwasser and reimagining our house ideas in this style.
- Design a building using an architectural style with different views
